As students enroll for their Senior year of high school one of the options available through is the Vocational & Technical classes offered through Hutchinson Community College and the Hutchinson Career & Technical Education Academy is Fire Science. Inman High School seniors interested in a career in Fire Fighting can attend classes in the Fall Semester 2018 at the McPherson Center from 1-3 p.m. to get the initial certification. This Fall the Academy is scheduled to meet from August 20-December 13, four days a week, Monday-Thursday.

Students cost will be to purchase textbooks and protective hood/gloves. Estimated Cost will be \$325.00 - \$350.00. Tuition is covered through CTE for all high school students attending. Courses students will complete in the Fall include Firefighter I, Hazardous Materials Operations First Responder, Fireground Operations, Introduction to Fire Protection and Suppression and CPR, First Aid, Blood – borne Pathogens.

Inman High School students attending should be able to take all cores in the regular classroom with Inman High School staff.
