This will be our nineteenth year for the Walter F. and June A. Bunting Academic Scholarship, which will be made available through a scholarship competition for legal dependent children of Bunting Magnetics Group employees for the 2019-2020 school year. The purpose of the scholarships is to increase the potential for success in continued education for employees' children, whether they pursue college or vocational education after high school.

The scholarship money available for 2019-2020 may be divided among several candidates, but has averaged around \$500.00 per candidate. This can total up to \$2,000.00 over a 4-year period for those continuing their post-high school education.

#### Eligibility

1. Previous scholarship winners who are continuing their post-high school education.
2. High-school seniors (graduating in May 2019) with post-high school plans.
3. Current vocational or undergraduate college students who are continuing their post-high school education.

Legal dependent children of all permanent full-time employees are eligible for this scholarship competition. Enrollment in the Fall 2019 semester and Spring 2020 semester must be confirmed before the scholarships can be paid.

#### Application and Essay Competition
