Application Details and Rules:

1. The applicant is to fill out the online application form and upload photo, resume and supporting application documents.
2. All fields in the application must be completed. Documents not specifically asked for in the application will not be reviewed.
3. Applicant will receive a confirmation email once the application is received.
4. Applicants will receive a letter after the scholarship committee has determined awardees.
5. A certificate will be awarded to high-school recipients at awardees' school function.
