## **Inman School Bond Project Begins**

**Inman, KS.** The USD 448 bond project is now underway. The majority of the project is being financed by the bond, but a portion is being paid for through nearly \$650,000 in private donations.

"We are overwhelmed by the generosity of this community," said school board chair Jessica Schierling. "The project was going to be great, but now with the support of people in Inman, we will have a higher quality, safer synthetic turf on the football field in addition to the rest."

The final scope of the project includes: New synthetic turf football field with new goalposts; new synthetic 7-lane running track with matching long jump and triple jump runways and pits; synthetic track surfacing at south D-zone for high jump areas; two new pole vault runways and landing zones (not including equipment); new 750 seat home grandstands with new three-compartment press box; storm drainage system throughout football and ball diamond facilities; new combination admissions, concessions and restroom building; a new natural grass baseball field; a new natural grass softball field; new baseball and softball field lighting, fencing, and accessories; new throwing areas for shot put, discus and javelin; and the reinstallation of existing scoreboards for baseball, softball and football fields.

The district's construction manager, Hutton, began demolition, earth work and mass grading in mid-December. The project is schedule to be completed in July 2023.
