ACT Prep class for Inman High School Students

When: Tuesday, Oct. 10, 2023. 8:00 am – 12:30 pm

Where: Kingdom Life Church Meeting Room, 505 South Ridge Road, Hesston, Ks. 67062. Students would have to provide their own transportation.

Cost: \$60 if registered before Oct. 1. \$70 if registering after Oct. 1

Why take this class? This class includes practical and relevant information on how to increase your ACT score. The workshop shows you how to control the test and not let it control you! The workshop also covers what will be on the test and how to master test-taking techniques. **This class is not a practice test!** Learn general ideas about the ACT as a whole and what the individual tests cover.

***Requests for refunds will have a \$20 processing fee deducted if cancelled more than 1 week prior to the first-class date. Cancellations within a week of the first class date will not receive a refund. Make-up classes are not offered for partial attendance. No-show students are nontransferable and nonrefundable.**

This class fills quickly; registrations are prioritized by date received. **Class size varies based on host location, but complies with local CV19 guidelines.** Upon receipt of payment all registrants will receive a confirmation email.

Payment for this course does not register you for the official ACT. Students must register and pay for the ACT at actstudent.org.

Carolyn DeVane has been teaching ACT Prep classes since 1999 and has been to Inman HS several times to hold prep classes. There are current Inman HS seniors who have taken this prep class and have shared they felt it really helped them be prepared for the ACT and improve their score if they had tested previously.
